IT WAS A SEESAW BATTLE IN PARKERSBURG AS THE 1975 STATE CHESS CHAMPIONSHIP ENDED IN A THREE WAY TIE BETWEEN DONALD GRIFFITH , ROBERT SMITH AND GARY CUMMINGS. ALL FINISHED WITH A SCORE OF 5 - 1. GRIFFITH SUFFERED HIS ONLY LOSS TO WILSON GIBBINS , WHO WAS AT ONE POINT ALONE IN THE LEAD. SMITH LOST TO MARVIN BARKER , AND CUMMINGS DREW WITH COUNTS AND DUDLEY. IT WAS CUMMINGS WHO HAD THE DISTINCTION OF BEING THE ONLY PLAYER TO FINISH WITHOUT A LOSS.

HAVING ONLY HALF THE NUMBER OF THE PREVIOUS YEAR'S PARTICIPANTS DID NOT HINDER THE EXCITEMENT OF THIS EVENT. WITH MAJOR UPSETS TAKING PLACE AT EVERY TURN , THE LEAD CHANGED IN EACH OF THE LAST THREE ROUNDS UNTIL BEING SETTLED BY A DRAMATIC CONFRONTATION BETWEEN PAT KELLY AND GARY CUMMINGS. KELLY , LEADING BY A HALF POINT AT THE END OF FIVE ROUNDS , COULD HAVE BEEN THE SOLO CHAMPION WITH A WIN. THERE WERE SO MANY IN CONTENTION DURING THE LATER ROUNDS THAT IT WAS TRUELY 'ANYBODY'S GAME'.
