

## EDITOR'S COLUMN

I had hoped this issue would be smaller than the previous two. As you can see, it isn't. This is due to a great deal of hard work done by one of my associate editors; Carl Kiser, who typed twelve pages of this bulletin by himself. Also the fact that there has been no slowdown in chess activity in the Mountain State added to this issue's size. All in all, a positive sign for chess in West Virginia.

However, this brings to the forefront one of two major problems facing the membership of the association: Bulletin expense! With three or four issues a year being published, the cost of producing and mailing the bulletin has risen dramatically. This year the postal service did away with mailing any letter, magazine, or package under four ounces via third class postage. As a result, postage expenses for the bulletin nearly tripled! The question which must be faced is: Do you wish to continue to get three or four bulletins a year? If the answer is 'yes' then a dues increase will be necessary.

The second problem is one of getting more chessplayers into the association by having tournament directors require W.V.C.A. membership at tournaments throughout the state. I chaired a committee, appointed at last year's business meeting, to look into this problem. Committee members Charles Szasz, Phillip M.(Mike) Lewis, and myself discussed ways of accomplishing this goal ranging from disbarment of TDs who didn't co-operate with the association and determination of types of tournaments in which W.V.C.A. membership dues should be required, to monetary incentives to TDs and sponsoring organizations for requiring W.V.C.A. membership. A consensus was arrived at whereby the monetary incentive approach should be tried with a possibility of a penalty to those TDs who still refuse to co-operate. Of course the monetary incentive would have to come from the membership dues which would in turn reduce funds available for bulletin expenses. Thus in order to implement this idea, a dues increase would be necessary.

As you can see the W.V.C.A. is facing a fiscal crisis with two vital interests at stake: growth of the association and the maintenance of quality and quantity we have come to expect of the bulletin. I hope those of you who will be attending the state business meeting this year will think about these problems in earnest. They must be answered.

## TOURNAMENT NEWS

A tremendous amount of chess activity characterizes the tournament scene this issue with most of it being one-day 'tornado' style events. Congratulations to Paul Homer, Manual Armada, Tracy Perkins, Dr. Bernard Kiernan, John (red) Roush, Andy Glancy, and Charles Jones for winning in these events. Two other events the Charleston East - West Match and Charleston Junior - Senior Match were won by the East and Juniors respectively. Additionally, there is the corrected(!) crosstable of the Closed U.S. Championship for this year. We scooped Chess Life & Review on this!!

Last, the Kanawha Valley Open. This proved to be another very strong

Charleston tournament with one master, five candidate masters, and nine category I players. The first round, just like the Charleston Open, gave strong indication of an unusual tournament when Manual Armada(2026) lost to Julio Torres(1440). The second round was even bloodier for higher rated players when Charles Schulien(2243) from Ohio lost to Michael Callinan(1880) from New Jersey and John Roush(2069) lost to Mike Lewis(1787). Paul Homer(1575) also was able to extract his pound of flesh for his loss in the Charleston Open to Steve Canterbury(1899). The carnage continued the rest of the tournament with John Roush and Steve Canterbury both being victimized again in later rounds. It seems as if those weaker(?) players don't respect those higher ratings. About now some of you are wondering what about Griffith and Barker? Well, Donnie went to the U.S. Open in California, posting a fine 7 1/2 - 4 1/2, thus avoiding all the fun and upsets. I chose to go the Lawrence Pfefferkorn Open in North Carolina, got wiped by two masters in the first two rounds, beat a category I in the third, withdrew and came home to see the finish of the K.V.O. Anyway the winner of the tournament is Dennis .....? Dennis Funkhouser???? Well not exactly as Mike Carey of Tennessee tied him at 4 1/2 - 1/2. But, I guess it does go to show that nice guys do finish first once in a while. Congratulations on a good showing.

Minutes Annual Meeting August 30, 1980

The annual meeting of the West Virginia Chess Association was held on August 30, 1980 at Dunbar West Virginia.

President Donald Griffith called the meeting to order.

The minutes of the last meeting and financial statement for the previous year were read and both approved.

## 1981 Championship Tournament

Site: Vernon Hart proposed that it be located in Clarksburg and in conjunction with the Italian Heritage Festival.

Tom Slamecka proposed Bluefield as the site. Charleston was also discussed.

Pat Kelly moved that no additional sites be proposed. Seconded and passed.

Joe Barker moved that Charleston not be considered in the selection. Seconded and passed.

Joe Barker moved that Clarksburg and Bluefield both offer definite details and commitments on their sites within thirty days to be submitted to the executive committee for selection no later than December 1980. Seconded and did not pass.

Pat Kelly moved the same motion except that it be submitted to membership by letter and ballot to be received back no later than November 30, 1980. Seconded and passed.

It was moved and seconded that fees, rounds, and times of rounds remain the same. Passed.

A motion was made that a larger base be installed on the rotating trophy to accommodate more nameplates. Seconded and passed.

It was moved and seconded that the championship tournament for 1981 be closed. After discussion motion did not pass.
