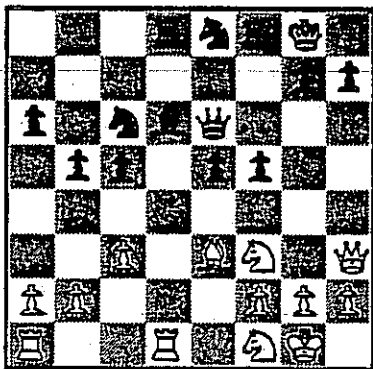
Editor,

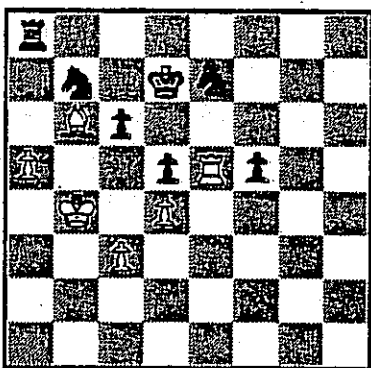

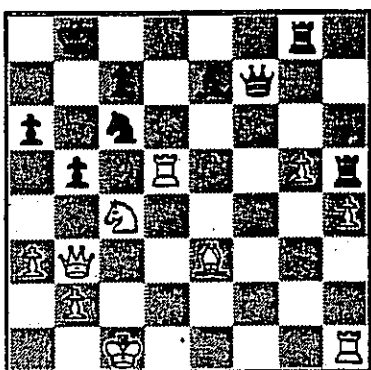

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# THE NATIONAL JUNIOR HIGH CHESS CHAMPIONSHIP 1982

On May 1,2 I played in the National Junior High Chess Championship at Terre Haute, Indiana. This was the first national tournament I ever played in and I was very impressed with the number of players, the ratings of the top players, the excellent playing facilities and the way the tournament was conducted.

In my section, 8th grade and under, there were 284 players from over 40 schools and from 23 states. The top-rated player was Stuart Rachels, the nation's youngest master. (See Chess Life, February 1982) There were two experts and several kids who are on the top 50 lists. One player had just won the National Elementary School Chess Championship a few weeks before.

After 7 rounds Stuart Rachels, Chuck Lovingood (national rank 40 under age 16) and I were tied at 6½. Rachels and Lovingood drew each other in round 7.

In the 8th and last round Rachels beat Danny Edelman, an expert and national rank 16 under age 16, and I beat Lovingood who had drawn Rachels. Although Rachels and I were tied at 7½, I won the First Place Individual trophy on the first tie-break.

The Richwood, West Virginia team won the 12 th place team trophy in the 9th grade section, and a Richwood player, Mandy Facemire, won first place in her category.

I had a great time and made a lot of new friends. I played a lot of skittle games with a lot of players from the 9th grade section including some games against the top two players from Vaux Junior High (the Bad Bishops) whose team came in second this year after winning the tournament for 2 or 3 years in a row.

Next year I hope to have a team and play in the tough 9th grade section.
