Collecting Chess on Stamps

Most of us think of chess as a game to be played, either over-the-board or through the mail. There are other chess aficionados, though, who think of chess as something to be collected. And collect they do!

About 200 chess collectors belong to the Chess on Stamps Study Unit (CoSSU) of the American Topical Association. These collectors specialize in collecting postage stamps and other philatelic items from around the world, with each item in their collections having something to do with chess. There are two or three hundred postage stamps which have a topic of chess. Some of these show great chessplayers. Others picture various chess pieces, or commemorate a tournament or Chess Olympiad. Still other chess stamps tell us about the origins of the game, and about its history.

Some of the members of the CoSSU also collect non-philatelic items related to chess, such as autographs of world chess champions, Not-Geld (German money with a chess motif on it, dated during and after World War I), picture postcards with chess scenes, etc.

The President of CoSSU, West Virginian Wayne A. Gnatuk [45 Maple Avenue, Morgantown, WV. 26505] would be glad to answer questions about the Chess Collector's Club. Steff Duck and Delmar Webb of California sent a letter to the editor indicating ways of increasing chess activity at the club level. An excerpt from the letter follows :

Each club night is a tournament night. Usually a 5 round Swiss which is played once a week for 5 weeks. ... Players seem to thrive on the club competition and their ratings reflect the work they've put in on chess. In WV., it's hard to increase your rating as quickly as you are increasing your ability with only 10 or so tournaments a year. This also gives tournament directors experience, which allows them to raise the level of TD quicker.

~~People who work weekends or don't like to travel have another way of getting rated games. ...~~

We also have Sunday Quads with a \$3 entry fee. This also helps getting more rated games in. It could be a problem if you don't have access to a facility that would allow enough time for 3 rounds. ...
