BEN GOOD WINS PLSYC!

Ben Good won the “Put A Little Spring in Your Chess” tournament. (Oh for the days when everything was named “Some City Open”!) Joe Barker, Mike Baker, Paul Davis and Markle Butcher finished in a massive pile up for 2nd at 2-1.

Bob Greer organized and directed the tournament which drew fourteen players to Bridgeport on May 18, 2013.

Here’s the Good-Barker showdown from round 3 with notes by Ben, himself.

Ben Good – Joe Barker Nimzovich Defense

1. e4 Nc6

Joe tries the Nimzovich defense, remembering my loss to Klaus Pohl at the state tournament in 2011 in the same opening. Of course Joe isn't Klaus, but that didn't stop him.

2. d4 d5 3. e5 f6 4. f4 Bf5 5. c3 Qd7 6. Nf3 Nh6

So far this is all typical Nimzovich.

7. Be3 O-O-O 8. Nbd2 e6 9. Bb5

I hadn't quite decided which way to approach things at this point. I was leaning towards kingside castling and a queenside pawn storm. I like the idea of putting the bishop on b5 just to restrict the knight and then if Black chases

it, I have another potential target on a6.

9... a6 10. Be2 Be7 11. b4

I'm not really in a rush to castle with the center being closed. I decided that I might as well strike while the iron's hot.

11... Be4 12. a4 Nf5 13. Bf2 fxe5 14. fxe5

14. dxe5 might actually be a little bit better to give the bishop some influence in the attack.

14... g5 15. Nb3

This is a little slow. I was eyeing the c5 square and was not too concerned about the coming move, but it isn't a necessity to play this way. After 15. O-O g4 16. Ne1 it looks like White's attack is stronger than Black's.

15... g4 16. Nfd2 Bxg2 17. Rg1 Nh4

{This just doesn't work. Black's pieces are overloaded. ♞ 17... Bh3 18. b5 Nb8 19. bxa6 bxa6 20. Na5 c5 21. Qb3 Qc7 22. Rb1 cxd4 23. cxd4

18. Nc5 Bxc5 19. Bxh4

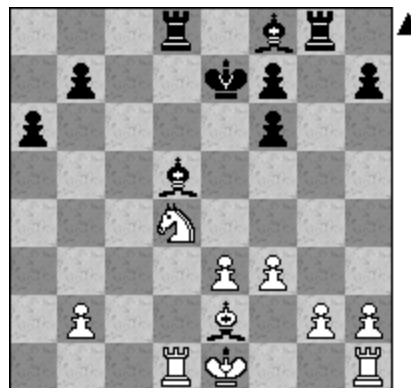

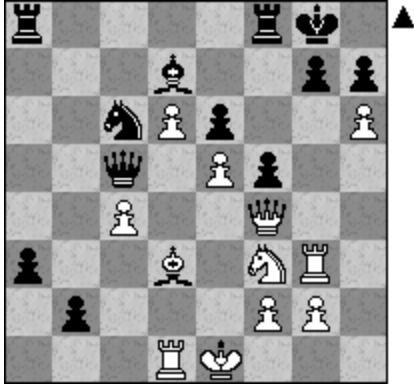

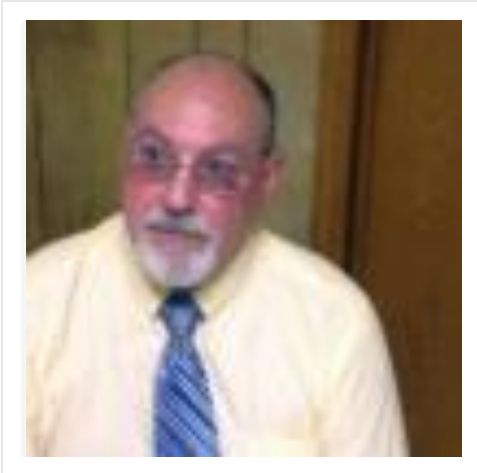
