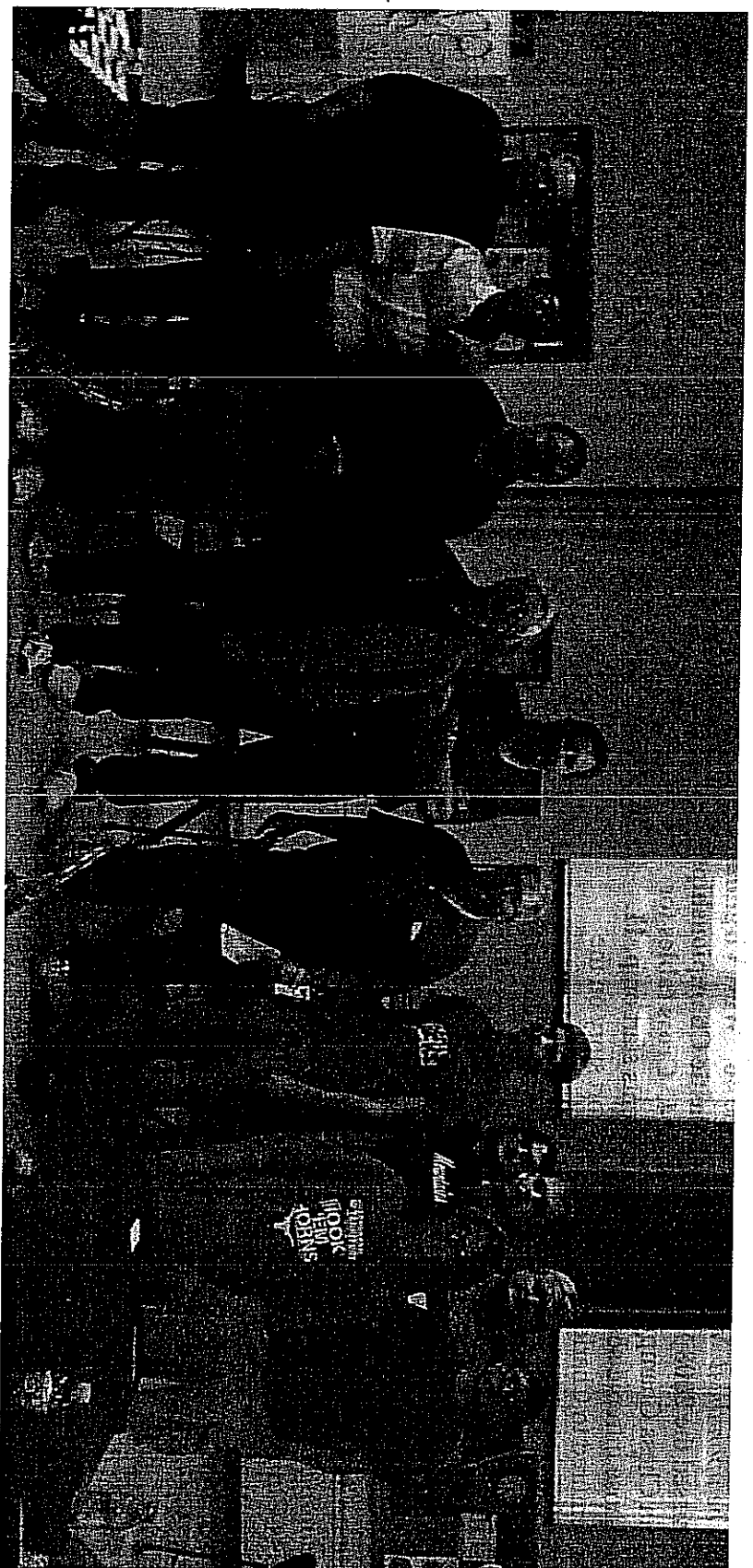

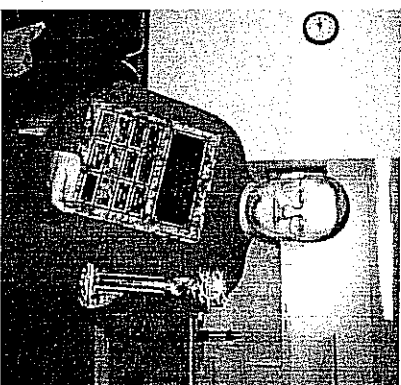
A short story on the **WVSCA Summer**

2008 WV ACTION CHAMPIONSHIP



BEN GOOD, 2008 ACTION CHAMP!

Ben Good, now a resident of the Clarksburg area, again won the WV Action Chess Championship. Despite viewing over 2/3rds of his game from just behind e8, he scored 5½ - 1½ to tie for first with Thomas Magar of Pittsburgh. Shih-Houng Young and Jimmie Beatty scored 5-2 to share 3rd and 4th places.

The tournament drew fourteen, which is about par for the Action tournament.

Here is the champion's Round One game. (Notes by Ben Good.)

{a3 is not a particularly useful move in this position. There is

nothing to fear of a ...Bb4 in the case of Nc3, and since the N is not on c3 already, a sequence like Bxc4 b5 followed by ...b4 is of no

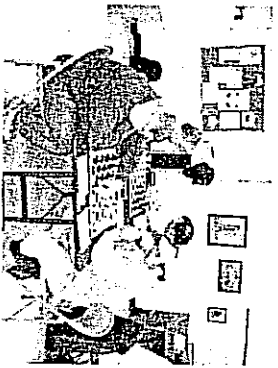
concern, either.}
5...Nbd7 6.Be2 dxc4
7.Bxc4 b5

{Black continues with the normal Meran system development}
8.Be2 Bb7 9.b4

{White further weakens his queenside pawns, perhaps because of concern for ...c5, although Black would first have to secure the b5 pawn.}
9...a5 10.bxa5 Qxa5+

11. Bd2 Qc7

{c7 was chosen rather than b6 with the thought of playing ...e5, which could influence the pawn structure on the queenside after White exchanges the d-pawn or allows Black to isolate the d-pawn. }

12. Qb3

{White is perhaps preparing for a B trade, which could give him better control of the dark squares. }

{Perhaps this was White's idea after all. I now decide to open the position and leverage the possibility

of attacking h2 and a1. }

{White daringly plays along. Nc3 is probably the better move, which would probably be answered with ...Qb8, disrupting the coordination of the Black pieces somewhat. }

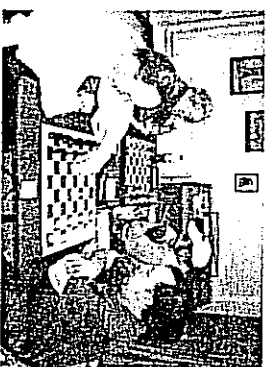

Thirty-two players attended the summer event hosted by Craig Timmons and John Homer. The open section was a 3-round swiss with 12 players.

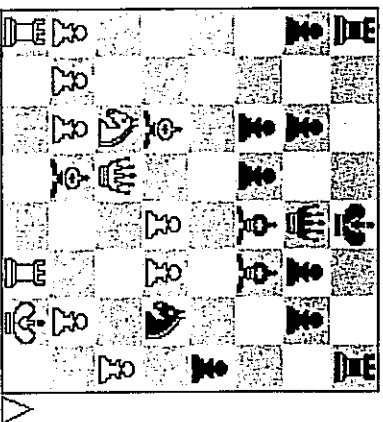

**WEST VIRGINIA CHESS
ASSOCIATION BYLAWS**

WVCA Bylaws

Revised: September 2007

The purpose of these Bylaws shall be to define specific policies governing the operation of the West Virginia Chess Association (WVCA) and the tournaments sponsored by the WVCA.

1. The meetings of the Board of Directors of the WVCA shall be open to all members of the club. These attending members shall have the right to taking the floor but cannot vote.
2. The fee for a Regular membership to the WVCA is \$10 for one year. The cost of a Life membership is \$140. The family membership costs \$20.
3. Annual State Chess Championship conditions of contest:
 - a. The annual State Championship shall be contested over Labor Day weekend.
 - b. The tournament shall be a six round Swiss section, open to all players.
 - c. The time control for the annual State Championship shall be conducted at thirty-five (35) moves in ninety (90) minutes, with (SD/1) sudden death in an hour.
 - d. The TD has the discretion to designate how to break ties.
 - e. The organizers of the State Championship are allowed to specify the entry fees.
 - f. Any WVCA member is eligible to win a class trophy, regardless of residency.
 - g. The local organization that is chosen to host the State Championship shall submit all details to WVCA officers four months prior to the latest time the announcements must be in to the USCF. A written contract with the site must be in

existence. If this is not done, the President shall have the responsibility and financial authority to select an alternative site and sponsor the tournament.

4. A WVCA Postal Championship may be held every two years. The format will be decided by the Postal Director. This event should be USCF rated.

5. The WVCA shall conduct a G-30 Action Championship to be held between March 1 and July 1. The event should be seven (7) rounds if possible. The bid for the Action tournament is to be separate from that of the State Championship. Bids should be presented at the annual business meeting held before the State Championship. The same residency and WVCA membership requirements for the State Championship apply.

6. The Bidding Process for the right to host the State Championships will be held annually at the WVCA Business Meeting. Bids to host the Action

Championship and the State Championship will be accepted separately. If there are multiple bids for an event, then the membership present will vote on the hosting site with a simple majority needed. In case of a tie, the current Moderator will break the tie. If possible, a backup site should also be obtained in case the winning bid cannot fulfill their award. If no bids are received, the Board of Directors will be tasked with finding an appropriate site for the Tournament.

7. The WVCA shall hold a Grand Prix Championship that will be based on performance over a year of events. The Grand Prix guidelines are as follows:

WVCA Grand Prix Rules

The Grand Prix is a yearly competition to reward overall performance rather than performance in an individual event. Grand Prix Points shall be calculated for each tournament and standings posted on the WVCA web site after each Grand Prix tournament is complete. Only

members of WVCA can earn Grand Prix points.

3. Prizes will be awarded as follows:

1. Grand Prix tournament requirements:
 - a. Must be open to all entrants
 - b. Must be at least four (4) rounds
 - c. Time control must be Game/60 minutes or slower except for the WVCA Action Championship
 - d. An event registration fee of \$10 must be provided to the WVCA to cover prize costs. The State Championship is exempt from this fee.
 - e. Must be conducted in West Virginia. A WV chess club may hold a Grand Prix tournament in a city bordering WV, such as Belpre, OH or Bluefield, VA.
 - f. Tournament shall be announced on the WVCA web site at least 30 days prior to the event.
2. The Grand Prix cycle ends with the WVCA State Championship.
 - a. 1st place shall be awarded \$50 if five or fewer Grand Prix events are held. The prize should increase \$10 for each event over 5, not to exceed \$100. The Board of Directors of the WVCA has discretion in designating the prize amounts.
 - b. Plaques or trophies shall be awarded for 1st through 3rd places. Additional plaques may be awarded for lower finishers if the Grand Prix budget allows. Again, the Board of Directors has discretion in determining the number of plaques/trophies to award.
 - c. Prizes shall be awarded after the completion of the WVCA State Championship. The Grand Prix coordinator shall attempt to have the calculations completed during the WVCA State

Championship to present the awards at the end of the championship tournament.

4. Grand Prix point calculation:

a. Players shall be awarded Grand Prix points based on their scores in a tournament. A player will receive 10 times the win percentage they achieved in the event, excluding non-forced byes. For example: a player that scores 6.5 out of 7 will earn $10 * 6.5/7 = 9.3$ points.

i. A voluntary bye shall be counted as a loss for point calculation. The bonus point calculations below do not consider byes or other unplayed games. For example: a player that wins 3 games and takes a half-point bye for the last round will earn $10 * 3/4 = 7.5$ points.

ii. Grand Prix points will be awarded at a reduced rate for a reserve section of a tournament. If the reserve section is Under 1800 or above (U2000, U2200, etc.), the rate shall be 75% of the open section. If the reserve section is between 1400 and Under 1799, the rate shall be 50% of the open section. For reserve sections below Under 1400, the rate shall be 25% of the open section. For example: a player that finishes with 3/4 in the Under 1600 section will be awarded $10 * 3/4 * .50 = 3.75$ points.

b. Players will receive one point for participating in an event.
c. Bonus points shall be awarded as follows:¹

¹ Non-WVCA members are to be used in the calculation of place and class prizes. They will not be included on the standings list, but their places in an event shall be used in the calculation. For example: if a non-member wins first place and a member places second, the member will only be awarded the second place bonus points.

² Class Prizes are to be awarded to those rated Under 1200, Under 1400,

Under 1600, Under 1800, and Under 2000. The prizes are awarded in the same manner as cash prizes. For example: if two players rated 1700 finish with a higher score than a player rated 1900, they will split the bonus points for the Under 2000 and Under 1800 class prizes. A player is awarded the higher point total if he/she qualifies for multiple prizes. The USCF rule book shall be consulted on any other circumstances not explained above.

³ The total number of players in a tournament is used to determine the classification of a split-section tournament. For example: if 7 players are in the Open section and 9 in the Reserve section, the tournament qualifies for the higher Grand Prix points based on having more than 15 total players.

⁴ In a split-section tournament, class prizes will only be awarded in the lowest section possible for that class. Furthermore, no class prizes will be awarded for

the highest class of a reserve section. For example: In a tournament with an Open section and an Under 1600 section, class prizes for Under 1400 and Under 1200 will only be awarded to those in the reserve section. Under 1400 or 1200 players in the Open section are considered to be "playing up," and must compete for the Under 1800 and Under 2000 class prizes (or place prizes). There will also be no Under 1600 class prizes as this is the highest rating group of the section.

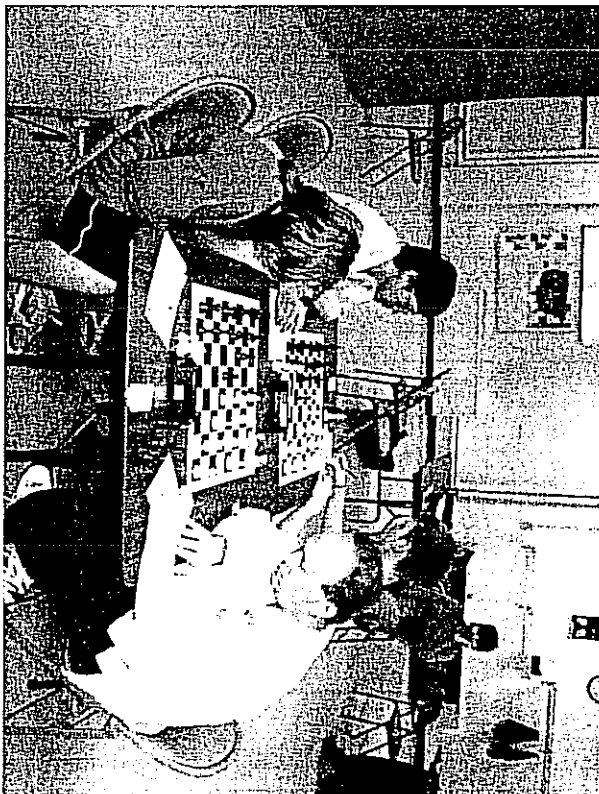

All this reminds us of Dr. V. S. Hayward of Huntington, West Virginia, who will allow us to stretch things a bit and call Father Time a "reformer". He certainly works some potent transformations.
